# Exodus Updates News and Notes from the Heart of the Ministry

Hello Shane,

#### WHO WILL CATCH YOU IF YOU FALL?

We recently saw a meme that said: "If you've ever had a 'move back in with your parents phase'yet look down on homeless people, you may need to reevaluate yourself because the only difference between you and them is you had someone to catch you when you fell." This statement truly describes many of the people we are seeing who don't have a support system that could take them in when they lost a job, could no longer afford rent, or faced other major financial hurdles.

With the cost of housing increasing by double digits, food prices at a 30-year high, and other daily living expenses like transportation, clothing, and health care outpacing wage increases, more people (including seniors) are finding themselves a paycheck or two away from the streets. Services like ours are crucial to helping these individuals navigate their way back to stability again. Homelessness can no longer be ignored because it is coming to a neighborhood near you!

Our resource center works with this vulnerable population to help them overcome the many hurdles they face when trying to find their way back to a steady life. People often say "Why don't they just get a job?" but when we explain that they're having difficulty getting one because they don't have an ID, a phone, or reliable transportation; or they can't afford a place with the salary they are making because our community has a major shortage of affordable housing units, people begin to understand the multi-dimensional challenges that occur once someone falls through the cracks.

We work to help these individuals find their way back. We begin by meeting their basic needs (food, clothing, hygiene services, and other supplies) and then work to build a relationship with them to understand the challenges that led to their current situation. We then walk alongside them as we connect them to resources that will help on their journey toward housing. 
- Needs this month: men's and women's athletic shorts (elastic waist), flip flops, bug spray, sunscreen, and cases of water.
